

Call for Expressions of Interest: Membership of *The London Journal* Editorial Board

The London Journal is seeking expressions of interest for new members of its Editorial Board with expertise in the following periods: **1700–1850** and **1900–1940**. We are also looking for someone who can take on the role of **Joint Book Reviews Editor**.

The London Journal is a multi-disciplinary periodical embracing all aspects of metropolitan society past and present. Members of the Board oversee the peer review process of article submissions in their field, and they are expected to solicit submissions, promote the *Journal*, and attend (in person or virtually) meetings of the Board, at which policy decisions are made. They should be actively involved in researching and publishing on London topics. Expressions of interest are particularly welcome from groups currently underrepresented in journal publishing and from **early career scholars**. You do not need to be located in the UK.

The **Book Reviews Editor** will cover the period from roughly 1700 to the present, joining Kirstin Barnard, who covers the medieval and early modern periods. The Book Reviews Editors are full members of the Editorial Board.
